

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

All personal belongings are to be labelled. We prefer that children leave their personal belongings at home i.e. (no toys, iPad, valuables etc.) except for any approved items;

- a lunch bag,
- a backpack
- a filled water bottle,
- Nap Kit- (Flat sheet, sleeping mat, or blanket and Pillow)
- one change of clothing (in a large Ziploc bag)
- a week's supply of diapers and wipes for our infants and junior toddlers
- items specified on supply list

Please be careful when selecting show and tell items or share, which it is something they are willing to share. Please no swords or guns of any kind. If they are unwilling to share, the item will be placed back in their cubby. Please do not bring anything that would cause hardship if lost or broken. We will not assume responsibility for any lost, stolen, misplaced or damaged personal belongings.

Please pack snacks in clean lunch bag adding an ice pack to maintain temperature of cold foods.

Nap Kits will be sent home on the last day of each week, and it is mandatory that bedding be laundered before being returning to the school.
